

Proposed changes to Downton Parish Council Burial Regulations point 3.11

The Regulations will be preceded with the following statement:

'Older existing graves/cremation plots may have differently arranged memorials. This is historical and is not considered to have set a precedent for future memorials.'

3.11 It is usual practice that No grave shall be raised by the use of turf, or any other means, above the level of the ground in the immediate vicinity. Downton Parish Council is willing to consider the installation of kerbing within the confines of the grave plot by application to the Clerk. Such kerbing will be only of stone or similar hard material, will have no adornment and will be raised no higher than 15cms (6 inches). Any infill within the kerbing will be of an approved material and will be underlaid with weed suppressing material. Relatives or nominated persons will be responsible for maintaining the grave area in a weed free situation.
