PL/2024/04659 Treeworks	LEICESTER HOUSE, 72 THE BOROUGH, DOWNTON, SALISBURY, SP5 3LY	T1 Yew tree - Fell to ground level.	By unanimous decision, leave to the Tree Officer to decide. Cllr Roberts abstained from voting, forfeiting his vote.
PL/2024/04950 Treeworks	TOWER VIEW, BARFORD LANE, DOWNTON, SALISBURY, SP5 3QA	T1 Magnolia - Crown reduce, prune from tips inwards up to 1-2 meters off height and sides, to maintain at reasonable size. T2 Ginko - Crown reduce, prune height from tips downwards by up to 6 meters to suitable points (previous pruning points) Reduce sides selectively to balance, to maintain at reasonable size. T3 Magnolia - Crown reduce, prune from tips downwards height by up to 2-3 meters, prune sides by 1-2 meters to balance and shape, to maintain at reasonable size. G4 Group of trees and shrubs on boundary consisting of Laurel, Hazel,	By unanimous decision, leave it to the Tree Officer to decide (whilst observing any signs of breeding activity for nesting birds, in consideration of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and the European Habitats Directive 1992/Nesting Birds Directive).

		Yew and Thuja. Prune back to previous points to boundary, pruning side branches only hanging over garden area, pruning by up to 1-2 meters off sides to suitable anatomical points, pruning to previous pruning points, to maintain boundaries, allowing light for smaller shrubbery beneath.
