

## Temporary Road Closure Order Town Police Clauses Act 1847

IN ACCORDANCE with Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, which section gives Wiltshire Council ("the Council") the power to make an Order for roads within its administrative area to be closed temporarily to all vehicular traffic (and for alternative routes to be observed) for the purposes of preventing obstruction.

The Council HEREBY ORDERS

On: **Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019** between the hours of **09.50 and 10.50**


Purpose: **Remembrance Sunday Parade and Service**

That the following roads and streets in the parish of **Downton** are to be closed (save in any case of emergency) to all vehicular traffic as set out below:

- a) **B3080 The Borough (Part)**; from a point approximately 170m east of its junction with A338 The Headlands in an easterly direction to its junction with B3080 High Street.
- b) **B3080 High Street (Part)**; from its junction with B3080 The Borough to its junction with Church Hatch;
- c) **Church Hatch**; from its junction with B3080 High Street for its entire length.

Nothing in this Order shall prevent vehicles from proceeding in the said lengths of road when being used in connection with the event stated above.
